- 6. Please dress accordingly to the weather! Wear gym shoes only! No flip-flops, spiked shoes, or cleats are allowed on the field.

- If your player is in a wheelchair **and asks for assistance**, please help by pushing them to their base. Your player might also need help getting from base to base. Please direct your player where they need to go.
- It is your responsibility to protect the player from any fly balls. If you retrieve the ball, please give it to a player to throw it in. Please stay close to your player, alert, and your eyes on the ball when pitched.
